Program Data

The Bagh Mitra Education Program was initiated in 38 villages on the peripheries of Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve in August 2022 as a part of the Dieter & Liz Gutmann Tiger Conservation Program after requisite training was provided by Dr. Dharmendra Khandal of Tiger Watch and others. By the conclusion of the first year, 5 program teachers together with 13500 students from 69 schools of 53 villages, covered 14 topics in environmental education in addition to a painting competition, a competitive quiz, an essay competition, regional museum tours and sports activity programs.

Preparation

Literature was prepared in simple language by combining chapters related to the environment from the textbooks of classes 3rd to the 10th of the school syllabus, with the addition of specially prepared chapters on Ranthambore's Geography, History and snakebite treatment. Along with this syllabus, painting competitions, quizzes, essay competitions, museum tours and sports activities were also organized in schools.

A 4-day long teacher training workshop was also organized in which subject experts Dr. Dhirendra Devarshi, Mr. Nimesh Ved, Mrs. Richa Gupta and his family, and Mr. Amar Deshpande conducted special sessions with the teachers of the Bagh Mitra Program.

Teacher Notes from the Workshop-

Dr. Dhirendra Devarshi:

Dr. Devarshi started his session with an introduction to the education policy of the government and gave information about the development of school and college level curriculums, in which he said that the school curriculum is set by the education board and the college curriculum is determined by the university. Whilst explaining all these things, Dr. Devarshi talked about the Gurukul education system, and how modern education system has been developed.

Referring to the modern education system, Dr. Devarshi said that when the British came to rule in our country, they thought it necessary to make changes in education to prepare suitable people to get Indians to do their work. Macaulay implemented a new education policy to further solidify rule in India. The British adopted this education system for their benefit, whose basic objective was for Indians to be Indian by color and blood, but they should be like the British in their outlook, Dr. Devarshi explained in further detail that ever since the British colonized India, they started changing the *Gurukul* education system, and stopped subjects like Sanskrit, ever since India's education system changed.

In 1966, Indians formed the Kothari Committee and raised the subject of education fund, but even after independence in India, there was no significant change in the education policy.

Till 1976, education remained the subject of the center and after 1986, education became the subject of the state, in 1986, the National Education Policy was formulated, in this way, adding or removing any point or subject matter in the curriculum of the education program has been depending on the technical and problems over time. As per the opinions of the community and the experts, the subject kept changing. He said that if it is necessary to teach something in training, then it is necessary to forget the inappropriate methods. Education should take a new form, so it is necessary to change from time to time based on technology.

Dr. Devarshi asked us to keep the following points in mind while preparing literature for environmental education.

1. Special attention to the characters - Whenever writing a book, gender (male and female) should not be discriminated based on various examples
2. On the basis of colour- Discrimination should not be taught, and this should especially be kept in mind while writing poems, stories and riddles.
3. On the basis of society/community- While writing the syllabus, words that have a negative impact on any particular society or community should not be mentioned.

Explaining the difference between education and training, Dr. Devarshi said that education lasts for a long time like studying from class 1 to 12, whereas training is completed in a short period of time like a 4-day workshop.

Education focuses on information with attitudes while training focuses on skills

To become an effective teacher, both skill and knowledge are necessary.

KSAV formula provided by Dr. Devarshi-

- a. Knowledge - Information
- b. Skill – To test whether the education given to the children has been learned or not.
- c. Approach, Method, Attitude – Whether the student has learned the given knowledge and whether it has changed or not.
- d. Value – Thinking or importance, Morality

A teaching method should be adopted which takes students from the known to the unknown by explaining knowledge skills method and value.

By example, Dr. Devarshi explained that to make a bow, wood must be taken, and it has to be rotated, then both the ends have to be tied with a string and the bow will be ready, this will give information to the children; the vision was to hit the target with a bow and arrow. Where to shoot,

when to shoot, whom to shoot, who is the target? The knowledge of right and wrong determines values.

Giving information about education and practicing it can be done by both the teachers while the approach and values depend on the children. Although these are the two most important goals that a teacher must achieve.

While teaching the children, we were told how to familiarize students with the unknown by asking questions about the things seen in the environment around them.

To teach the syllabus in the classroom from the teachers, go with complete material preparation and talk to the children related to the syllabus.

Session-2

In this session, Dr. Devarshi gave everyone the task of presenting a lecture as if in a classroom environment so that he could critique their teaching methods.

Everyone prepared their own topics and presented them respectively.

Then the method was corrected through several examples

As-

Example 1 During that time, he asked that if water is poured into many glasses at the same time when kept below the fountain, whether all the glasses got equal amount of water or not?

The reason for this is that not everyone got the same amount of education given by us. He said that tapping into the environmental contexts of the students, so that we can know what they know.

Example 2 When children do mischief or make a mistake, they were advised how to correct indiscipline or misbehavior.

Dr. Devarshi advised for example that if the child was late in coming to school and without scolding him, say for example, 'look at your friend Mohan, he comes to the school cleanly every day at the right time and also pours water on the trees and plants in the campus.'

Make the offending student realize his mistake by pointing out children who have done commendable work in the class (thus creating a visible contrast).

Encourage good children by clapping, you can also praise them.

Giving examples of gifted children can bring changes in the working style of the child.

Mr. Nimesh Ved: -

1. Involving the teacher: Talked about environmental education that when we go to teach in a school, the first thing we do is to coordinate with the schoolteachers.

If when you go to teach, teachers remain in your class, then it is a very good thing, if the teacher is not sitting with you in the class or keeps on using their mobiles then he may give a wrong review of your work when you leave. While doing this, we should be friendly with the subject teachers and include their syllabus related to the environment in our educational activities.

2. Use of the five senses: Activities like camps should be organized to make the curriculum interesting for the children.

The five senses should be used by the teacher while teaching, so that students can learn easily.

The five sense organs are as follows: -

a. Eye- By showing the children something in their surroundings and telling the things written on the blackboard.

b. Ears-acquiring knowledge by listening, recognizing the sounds of birds, the sounds of wild animals, the wind, the fluttering of leaves, etc.

c. Nose- To identify a flower, leaf etc. by scent.

To tell about someone by word of mouth.

d. Skin - Detection of things by touch, like what kind of soil for example, information about them can be obtained by touching them.

3. He should be told the purpose of environmental education by doing activities related to the environment through materials used, traditional games, sports like clay toys or natural things etc.

Books related to environment.

identification of trees by leaves or pictures,

Describing about our work, he said that before doing any work, it is checked or not.

To do this work better one has to go through three points.

a. what to do.

b. how to do it.

c. why do it?

. Mr. Ved gives us examples of biotic and abiotic components of the environment and asks some questions like- do you have the resources?

What is the quality of your life.

He explained on that our life depends on the environment.

He identified biotic components-: trees, plants, animals, etc.

Abiotic components: - air, soil, heat, rivers, mountains, forests etc.

5. Shri Ved told us that the following things should be kept in mind while giving education to the children

Don't intimidate the students,

If children are getting education in a fearful environment, then they will not even ask questions and will not answer.

In our school children from class 1 to 3 are not taught with the help of any book and keep their studies interesting by organizing camps for the children.

develop the ability to talk in children,

What did you want to become and what did you become? Don't tell the children to become like me, rather the child can become more than that. Don't focus the the children on certain degrees or job future etc.

He said that children should not be embarrassed or humiliated while teaching; children should first complete their syllabus through an interesting environment.

Ved ji also said that we can include the main points from children's books in our curriculum, for which he also ordered environment books from class 3 to 10, but due to a lack of time, we could not complete them. Ved ji said that our life is dependent on the environment.

Mr. Amar Deshpande:-

Mr. Deshpande said that he should explain the methods of teaching children through many activities. So that children can get good information in sports and their knowledge can be developed.

Mr. Deshpande discussed the topics of trees, plants, water pollution, soil pollution, air pollution, etc.

1. Told us about the disposal of garbage that we should collect dry and wet garbage separately and divide the garbage into two types.

Dry waste: - Plastic items, clothes, iron items, glass, steel etc.

Wet Garbage: - Wasted remains of vegetables, rotten fruits, flowers, leaves, unused grass left in animal fodder etc.

In response to the garbage things which are useless in our lives, he said that the garbage which is visible to us today, tomorrow the same garbage can prove to be useful in increasing economic income along with essential items for a particular person. .

In the example, we said that by weaving cloth from torn clothes, making a new carpet, it is useful for us to lay it again.

2. There is a difference between want and need, giving an example in himself, he told that the thing we need is our need and the thing we do not need but we have desired that thing as our convenience or beauty. Whether to keep or buy is a matter of choice.

He told that when we go to teach children, we can make the teaching method interesting and fun through small activities suited to the environment there. Mr. Deshpande also got us to do an activity called -

3. Treasure Hunt: An activity that we all participated in very enthusiastically. They prepared seven clue chits and gave separate chits to our two groups. We had to read that chit and find the place or object. Everyone enjoyed this activity and our ability to think and understand developed because of it. We had to find that place or object after reading the chit, everyone enjoyed this activity and our ability to think and understand developed because after reading that article we had to find that object with concentrated mind,

4. Mr. Deshpande told us about water audits and that we can do this activity keeping in mind the water conservation in our village, school etc. in which we can save water. When the children go to school to drink water, how much water is wasted and, in some taps, water still drips even after turning off the taps. In this way, we can save the wasted water by getting the taps repaired. can,

5. He said that by knowing the names of trees and plants located around us, we can discuss and ask children questions about their color, size, shape of leaves, structure, type of roots, etc.

6. To identify the trunk of a tree, we can identify the structure of the trunk by rubbing it on a white blank paper with the help of a pencil.

We can identify the name of birds even by listening to the sound of birds.

He told us that through the *Satolia* game, we can also give information about the food chain to the children, in this way he gave us detailed information.

By finding news related to environment from 8 newspapers, got information about useful things.

7. Deshpande ji told us that if the children are making a noise, then how can they be pacified. By calming them down and getting them to start recognizing the teacher's voice.

8. Deshpande ji also gave us a puzzle-like table in which answers related to wildlife and trees and plants were hidden, we were given questions related to them and then asked to sort out the answers according to the questions given in the table.

Rajiv Gandhi Natural History Museum Sawai Madhopur Tour

At the end of the academic year, students from various schools were taken on a tour of Rajiv Gandhi Natural History Museum, Sawai Madhopur. This tour gave them a direct insight to dimensions of wildlife. 768 students and 75 teachers participated in this tour, who are associated with 24 schools of 17 villages around Ranthambore.

These students were brought to Sawai Madhopur by the resources of private transport and after the program they were dropped to a pickup point. During this tour, the children looked at the various parts of the museum carefully for about 1 hour and 30 minutes and all the teachers of the program explained the important information by reading the board. The desert, the Western Ghat, the birds, the different rooms representing local wildlife were seen with interest.
